Dear Residents of the Town of Munster & Town of Dyer:

FHP/RB JV will be rolling a bridge into a permanent position to further the West Lake Corridor project at the CSX track near the intersection of Main St and Sheffield Ave **starting at 7:00 PM on Tuesday, May 27 through 11:00 PM on Wednesday, May 28, 2025.**

The installation of the bridge will involve trackwork, excavation, and rolling of the permanent bridge structure.

The roll-in curfew should not generate the same sound and vibrations that the JV previously notified residents in the area about in December and early January.

The intent is to conduct this scope of work with minimal impact to residents.

This scope of work will also require CSX Railroad outages that can only be provided during the hours proposed.
